- 5. Provision for all ages to grow in worship, fellowship, outreach, service, discipleship
- 6. Members and attenders of the church seek and see God grow greater in their lives so that relationships are healthy and wholesome, people feel cared for and loved and care for and love others;
- 7. A leadership team responsive to the Spirit of God and sensitive to the needs of the non-Christian community creating sustainable capacity for the growth of God's church in the local area;
- 8. To be financially sustainable and give to others in need including charities
- 9. The church a model and resource to church planting² in the locality;
- 10. Good relationships with local churches;

Dreams of Helping to Grow Churches

Shinfield Community Church was reborn 2014/15 with the support and help of Wycliffe Baptist Church. At that time another local church, seeing the fruitful way that Shinfield Community Church had been reborn, asked if 'Shinfield could do for them as a local church, what Wycliffe had done for Shinfield.' Since that moment Shinfield Community Church, knowing how it was helped by others, has actively sought to renew other churches or to start new churches through planting aware that we are in an area of considerable population growth.

Dreams Realised

In January 2020 Shinfield Community Church was invited to renew Beech Hill Baptist Church and it sent a team of seven people to do this. In 2022 a new congregation – Flourish – was started in Shinfield View Residential Home.

Dreams to Come

In planting, we've learnt from experience that being ready means that we can take hold of the opportunities God creates. But being flexible allows us to move well into those opportunities as they arise!
